Mary Poppins promises to be an unforgettable time at The Rose, with breathtaking dance numbers and spectacular stagecraft. Thanks to the talents of Hall Associates Flying Effects, several characters will appear to soar through the air, objects will move on their own, and Bert will literally do a head-over-heels rendition of "Step in Time."

"Disney's inventive adaptation of the Travers book and the resulting movie feels fresh, magical, and brimming with life," says Gutschick. "We are excited to bring the show to Omaha."

The eight children's books by P.L. Travers, published from 1934 to 1988, first introduced the magical nanny who floated into the lives of the Bank's family at 17 Cherry Tree Lane. Mary Poppins' encounters with chimney sweeps and other characters were re-envisioned in the Walt Disney film in 1964 starring Julie Andrews and Dick Van Dyke. The stage version was first presented in London's West End in 2004, then on Broadway in 2006 where it ran until March 2013. During this time it won the Olivier Award for Best Theatre Choreography and Best Set Design as well as the Evening Standard Award for Best Set Design and the Variety Club Award for Best Musical. The Broadway production won the Tony Award for Best Set Design.

Mary Poppins will be presented Fridays at 7 pm, Saturdays at 2 pm, and Sundays at 2 pm. Additional performances will be held Saturday, June 6 at 7 pm; Thursday, June 11 at 7 pm; Thursday, June 18 at 7 pm; and Saturday, June 27 at 7 pm. Interpretation for individuals who are deaf or hard of hearing will be offered at the 2 pm show on Saturday, June 13.
